In line with TasNetworks' procurement practices, engage and have oversight of third-party services where required.• Develop project management related documents as required, for example, work breakdown structure, budget, project plan, stakeholder register, schedule, risk register etc.• Communicate and engage positively and effectively with key stakeholders, building strong and productive working relationships.• Monitor progress towards compliance, reporting regularly to the Sustainability Committee and escalating emerging issues as required.• Provide advice, assistance and support to Functional Areas with accountabilities to achieve CRFD compliance.• Coordinate and chair the CRFD Working Group.• Any other duty or task as reasonably and lawfully directed by TasNetworks.
