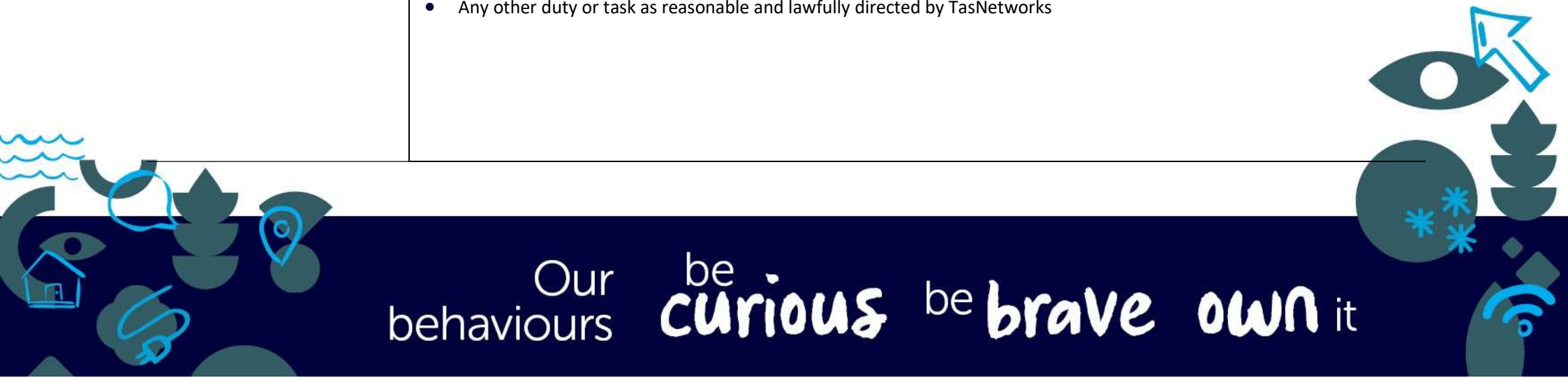
### Objectives
