Objectives

- Responsible for field-based oversight, quality assurance, and safe delivery of construction activities across the network;
- Collaborate with the TasNetworks Transmission and Distribution teams to ensure new overhead transmission line and distribution lines are compliant to the existing system and design standards;
- Ensure contractors meet technical standards, safety requirements, and project milestones while maintaining reliable service to customers;
- Complete all jobs on time, at estimated cost, and to the agreed standard.

Role Specific Accountabilities

- Work under limited supervision to conduct inspections of transmission line construction and associated civil and electrical works to verify compliance with project specifications;
- Work as part of a self-directed team to monitor contractor performance and workmanship, identifying non-conformances and escalating for corrective actions;
- Perform routine inspections, and verification checks on overhead transmission and distribution assets providing appropriate reporting outcomes;
- Ensure compliance to safety, environmental and service delivery standards;
- Ensure all works comply with safety legislation, environmental obligations, and organisational service delivery standards;
- Participate in incident investigations and contribute to risk assessments and safe work method reviews;
- Liaise with Contractors, Project Engineers, and Site Supervisors to support timely delivery of project milestones;
- Participate in response and network reliability requirements;
- Any other duty or task as reasonably and lawfully directed by TasNetworks.

- Certificate III in ESI - Transmission Overhead;
- Ability to work across remote or dispersed project sites;
- Transmission construction experience essential with live and de-energised conditions;
- Relevant experience in transmission or distribution network maintenance, or inspection, is most desirable;
- Hold a current driver's licence, heavy rigid (HR) vehicle licence, elevated work platform (EWP) licence, and other relevant industry qualifications.
- Ability to write and or review technical documentation, understand drawings and network configurations;
- Ability to work independently and as part of a team;
- Able to demonstrate the capacity to perform the inherent requirements of the role.
