Objectives

- An Apprentice Electrical Technician is responsible for constructing, inspecting and maintaining electricity infrastructure mainly associated with the underground mounted and ground mounted TasNetworks distribution network
- Common assets that will be worked with are high and low voltage cables, kiosk substations, street turrets and cabinets, building type substations, Zone substations and pole top switchgear

Role Specific Accountabilities

- Construction and maintenance of the overhead and underground electrical distribution network up to and including 22kV to relevant standards
- Conduct low voltage and high voltage switching operations
- Install and maintain public lighting, overhead conductors and cables
- Ensure compliance to company safe work practices and where necessary assist in training other team members in safe operating procedures
- Complete all necessary paperwork and reporting
- Locate and rectify faults on the distribution network
- Perform after hours duties as required and when requested be available for immediate emergency response
- Undertake operating on the distribution system up to and including 22kV
- Any other duty or task as reasonably and lawfully directed by TasNetworks.
