- An apprentice Distribution Lineworker works at the heart of our business. They install, repair and maintain the overhead and underground power network that supplies electricity to our customers
- As an apprentice Distribution Lineworker you'll perform the following tasks; maintaining power poles and wires and associated hardware, new asset construction, installing aerial equipment, emergency response work, investigating power supply problems and fault finding

Role Specific Accountabilities

- Construction & maintenance of the overhead and underground electrical distribution network up to and including 33kV to relevant standards
- Conduct low voltage and high voltage switching operations, whilst under supervision and mentorship of the Works Delivery Leader
- Inspect overhead structures and electrical apparatus
- Meet established TasNetworks quality and operational performance standards
- Install and maintain public lighting, overhead conductors and cables
- Ensure compliance to TasNetworks safe work practices and where necessary assist in training other team members in safe operating procedures
- Complete all necessary paperwork and reporting
- Locate & rectify faults on the distribution network
- Perform after hours duties as required and when requested be available for immediate emergency response
- Participate in Work Group Meetings and training programs
- Any other duty or task as reasonably and lawfully directed by TasNetworks.
