- Provide infield leadership, including the onsite management of crew time and workload, and provide direction to others aligned with work priorities.

- Build and maintain positive relationships with landowners to allow access to ensure major works and other activities run smoothly.

- Ability to plan and optimise the weekly schedule to ensure safe and efficient delivery outcomes for the crew.
